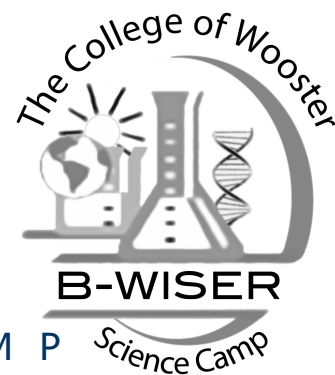

W H A T T O B R I N G T O C A M P

B-WISER camp is unique, so be prepared to handle **all kinds** of weather – warm/cool, rain/shine. **Old clothes that are comfortable, durable, and washable are recommended. Be sure to label your belongings.**

Pillow, linens for your bed (long twin size), and towels

Alarm clock

Personal hygiene products: soap, comb and/or brush, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.

Long jeans or pants in case of cool weather

Shorts

Shirts (mostly short sleeve)

Sweater or sweatshirt

Outerwear for the weather (such as: jacket, rain gear, hat)

Socks

Underwear

Pajamas

Comfortable everyday shoes AND an extra spare pair (no open-toed shoes for classes)

Refillable water bottle

Flashlight with good batteries (bring extra batteries)

Pencils, pens, sketchpad, notepaper, envelopes, stamps, postcards, reading materials (all optional)

Laundry bag or plastic garbage bags for dirty and/or wet clothes

Sunscreen and non-aerosol insect repellent

Shower clogs/shoes

Shower tote for personal care items

Camera if you wish to take pictures (**NOT cell phone, iPod, iPad, tablet, notepad, notebook, or laptop**)

Backpack, school bag, or tote

Money (optional - if you wish to purchase items in the bookstore)

An electric fan and extension cord (optional - this year the dorms will be air-conditioned)

Refillable water bottle (listed again because this is essential!)

6+ well-fitting COVID face masks (at least triple layer)

Snacks (no food, including gum – attracts 4 & 6 legged visitors)

Slick bottom shoes

Electronic devices – this includes cell phones!

The camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Campers will be given keys to rooms and encouraged to use them. The daily schedule will be so busy that spare time will be at a minimum, so there is no need to pack many recreational items.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS FOR ALUMNAE CAMPERS

Two extra jeans/pants for Environmental Science class

Long sleeve shirts

Hat for the sun

Hangers (recommended for hanging any wet clothes to dry)

Extra pair of tennis shoes – shoes may get wet during Environmental Science class

2 or more spare outfits (including socks) – for changing into after the Environmental Science class for attending afternoon classes

RUBBER BOOTS (If not available, you must have shoes to wear in water (NOT flip-flops) and other shoes for afternoon classes.)
